According to the Minister of Health Regulation 49 of 2019, the Community Health Center, hereinafter referred to as the Puskesmas, is a health service facility that organizes public health efforts and first-level individual health efforts, prioritizing promotive and preventive efforts in its working area.

Puskesmas is a first-level UKM. UKM in Permenkes 43 of 2019 concerning Puskesmas explains that Public Health Efforts (UKM) are every activity to maintain and improve health and prevent and overcome the emergence of health problems targeting families, groups, and communities. While Individual Health Efforts (UKP) are activities and / or a series of health service activities aimed at improving, preventing, curing diseases, reducing suffering due to disease and restoring individual health. The functions of the health center according to Permenkes 49 of 2019 are:

- a) Organizing first-level UKM in its working area In carrying out the function of organizing first-level UKM in its working area as referred to in Article 5 letter a, the Health Center has the authority to: 1) Prepare activity plans based on the results of the analysis of public health problems and the service needs required.
- b) Carrying out advocacy and socialization of health policies.
- c) Implementing communication, information, education and community empowerment in the health sector.
- d) Mobilizing communities to identify and resolve health problems at every level of community development in collaboration with regional leaders and other related sectors.
- e) Carrying out technical guidance for institutions, community health center service

- f) Implementing planning for needs and improving the competence of human resources at the Health Center.
- g) Monitoring the implementation of development to ensure it is health-oriented.
- h) Providing health services that are oriented towards families, groups and communities by considering biological, psychological, social, cultural and spiritual factors.
- i) Carrying out recording, reporting and evaluation of access, quality and coverage of Health Services.
- j) Providing recommendations regarding public health issues to district/city health services, implementing early warning systems, and disease control responses.
- k) Carrying out family approach activities.
- l) Collaborating with primary health care facilities and hospitals in their work areas, through coordinating health resources in the work areas of the Community Health Centers.

This research is analytical descriptive, namely research that aims to describe a situation or to find out things related to and explore in depth about things that influence the occurrence of something. (Kunto.A, 1993).

Nursing information systems related to legality in obtaining and using data, information and knowledge about documentation standards, communication, decision-making processes, developing and disseminating new knowledge, improving the quality, effectiveness and efficiency of nursing care and empowering patients to choose the desired health care. This information system is useful for organizations so that they can collect useful, accurate, reliable, detailed and relevant information (Zendrato & Sri Hariyati, 2018).

This study is in line with previous studies where the implementation of nursing care documentation at the nursing diagnosis stage was in the implemented category (94.33 %) (Maurissa et al., 2020).

Nursing implementation is a series of activities carried out by nurses to help
